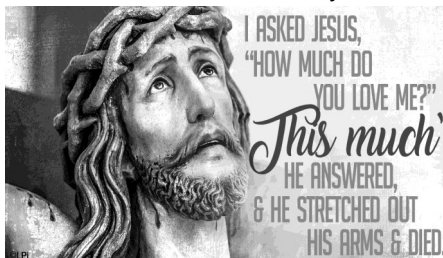

REVERE BY THE BLESSED PALMS

Because the palms are blessed, they are now sacramental, which "are sacred signs instituted by the Church. They prepare us to receive the fruit of the sacraments and sanctify different circumstances of life" (Catechism # 1667). Sacramental should be treated with respect and never be thrown away. Palms may only be burned or buried. The faithful, however, should be instructed as the meaning of this celebration so that they might grasp its significance. They should be opportunely reminded that important thing is participation at the procession and not only obtaining of palm or olive branches. "Palms or olive branches should not be kept as amulets, or for therapeutic or magical. Palms and olives branches are kept in the home as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the messianic king, and in his Paschal Victory".
