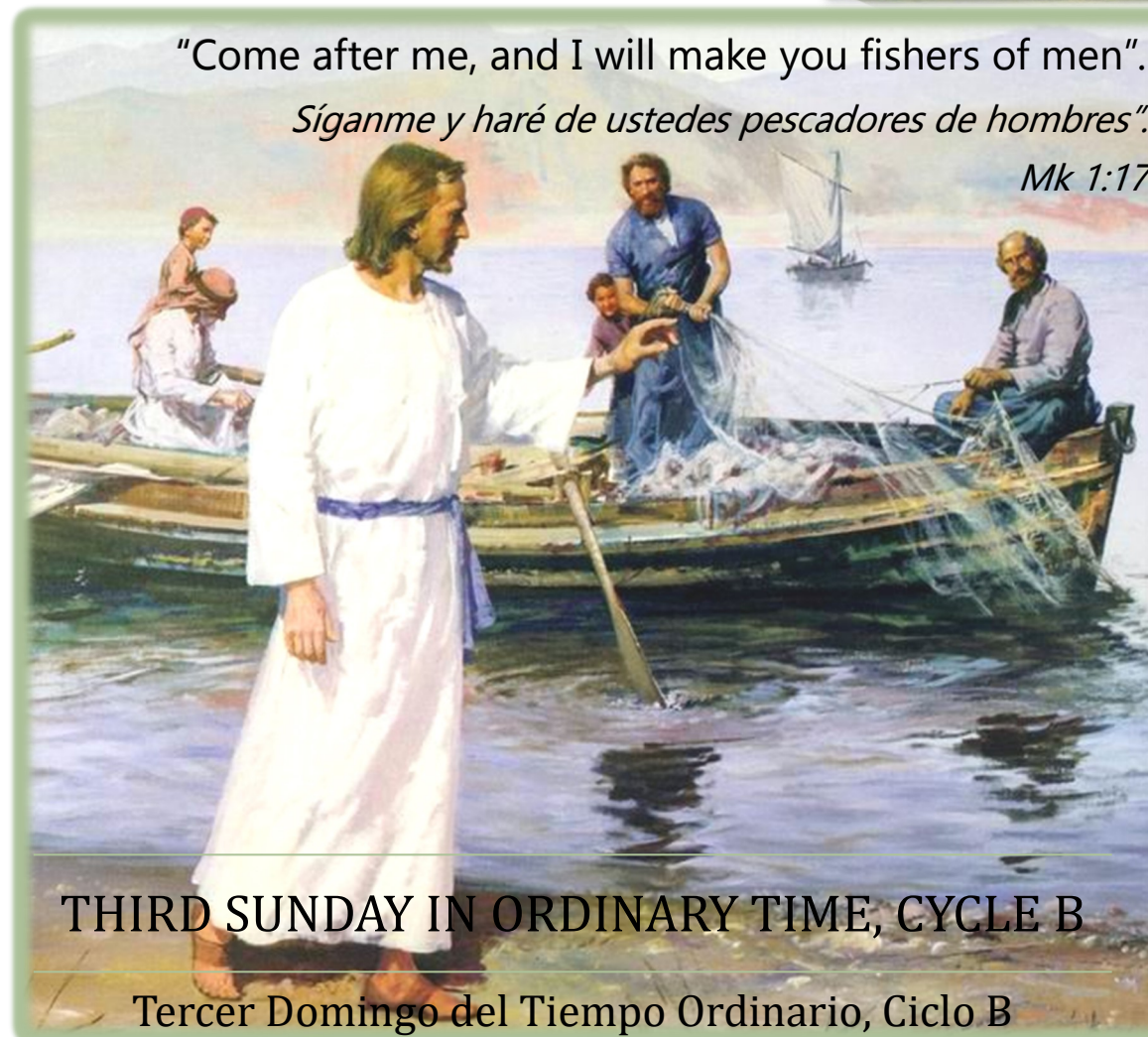

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO

Our readings today call on us to repent and to change our ways. They remind us that the pleasures of this earthly life are constantly changing and that only the Word of God can bring us everlasting happiness. In the first reading, we see the Prophet Jonah being sent to Nineveh to preach the Word of God there. The people realise their folly and change their ways returning to the Lord once more. In the gospel from St Mark, we see Jesus begin his public ministry with the words "The kingdom of God is close at hand. Repent, and believe the Good News." He then goes on to call his first disciples. Jesus invites us to participate in his mission: "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men." This is a life-transforming invitation and mission. By our baptism, we are each called to serve the Lord as did the people of Nineveh and the first disciples. So today, my dear friends, we are invited to discern how Jesus is calling us in our current situations and to respond with openness and trust. Let us say the words of today's Psalm with conviction, "Lord, make me know your ways . . . make me walk in your truth." God Bless! Father Eric

Nuestras lecturas de hoy nos llaman a arrepentirnos y cambiar nuestros caminos. Nos recuerdan que los placeres de esta vida terrenal cambian constantemente y que sólo la Palabra de Dios puede traernos la felicidad eterna. En la primera lectura, vemos al profeta Jonás siendo enviado a Nínive para predicar allí la Palabra de Dios. El pueblo se da cuenta de su disparate y cambia sus caminos volviendo al Señor una vez más. En el evangelio de San Marcos, vemos a Jesús comenzar su ministerio público con las palabras "El reino de Dios está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en la Buena Nueva". Luego pasa a llamar a sus primeros discípulos. Jesús nos invita a participar en su misión: "Seguidme y os haré pescadores de hombres". Esta es una invitación y una misión que transforma vidas. Por nuestro bautismo, cada uno de nosotros somos llamados a servir al Señor como lo hicieron el pueblo de Nínive y los primeros discípulos. Por eso hoy, queridos amigos, estamos invitados a discernir cómo Jesús nos llama en nuestras situaciones actuales y a responder con apertura y confianza. Digamos las palabras del Salmo de hoy con convicción: "Señor, enséñame tus caminos...has que camine con lealtad". ¡Dios los bendiga! Padre Eric

The journey begins at Dodge City Middle School (2000 Sixth Ave) at **10 a.m.** We will then reverently process to the Cathedral of our Lady of Guadalupe for Holy Mass and a meal.
