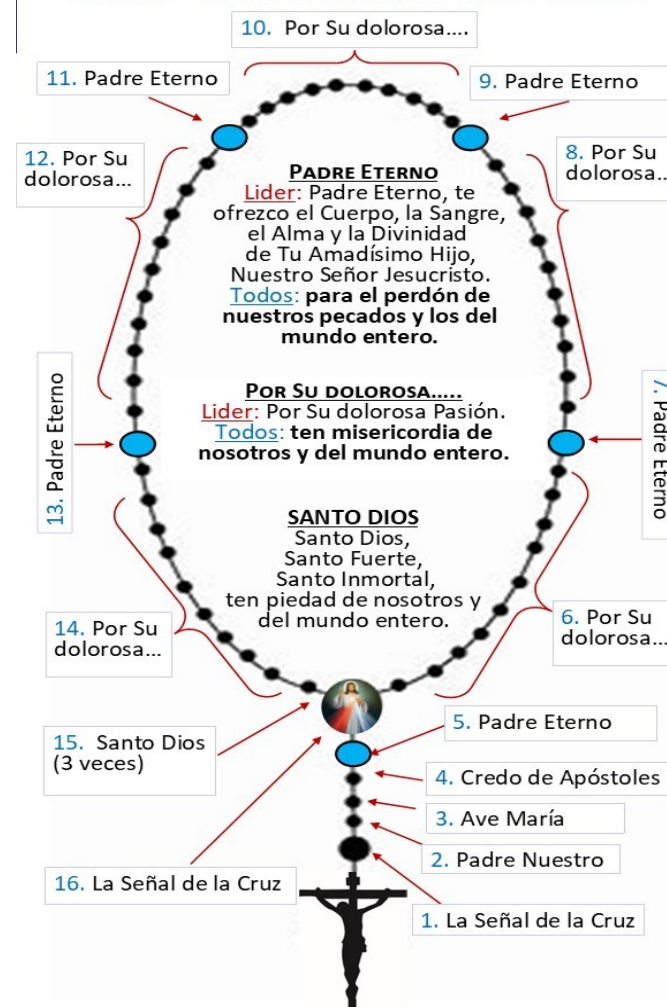

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO

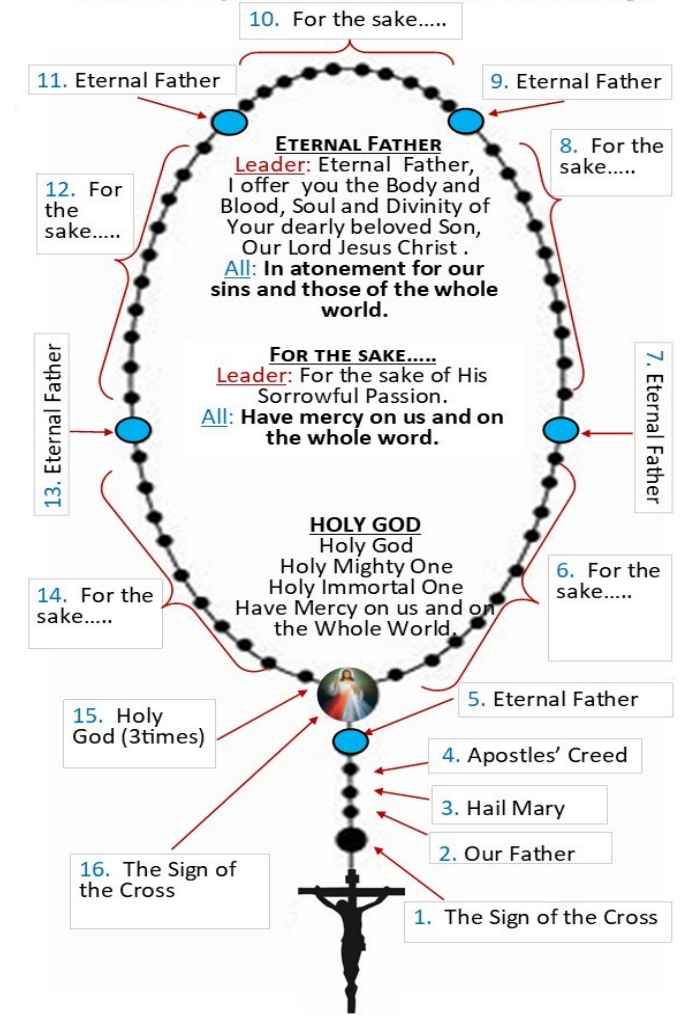
In our first reading today we read of the ideal way of living the Christian message – everyone united together in faith, looking out for one another and sharing their possessions for the good of all. Our gospel reading of today recounts the first visit of Jesus to his disciples eight days after the resurrection. The disciples are amazed but they are also filled with joy. Jesus then sends them out to preach the Good News to all people. Friends, important for us in this text is the fact that St Thomas was not there and because he did not see Jesus he refuses to believe. Thomas is there the next time Jesus returns and is told to put his finger in the wounds showing that Jesus knew what Thomas had said. We all doubt from time to time, as did Thomas, but Thomas represents each of us and receives the proof on our behalf. Therefore, with him, we are called on to say "My Lord, and my God." Another way of looking at this text is that perhaps Thomas refused to believe because of who it was he was listening to. Perhaps we too fail to accept something as true because of how we view those who are telling us. No matter who spreads the faith, the faith has Christ and the Holy Spirit behind it to confirm it and so we need to listen and to believe. God Bless! Fr. Eric

En nuestra primera lectura de hoy leemos sobre la manera ideal de vivir el mensaje cristiano: todos unidos en la fe, cuidándose unos a otros y compartiendo sus bienes para el bien de todos. La lectura de nuestro evangelio de hoy relata la primera visita de Jesús a sus discípulos ocho días después de la resurrección. Los discípulos están asombrados pero también llenos de alegría. Luego, Jesús los envía a predicar la Buena Nueva a toda la gente. Amigos, lo importante para nosotros en este texto es el hecho de que Santo Tomás no estaba allí y como no vio a Jesús se niega a creer. La próxima vez cuando Jesús regresa, ya estaba Tomás allí, a lo que Jesús le pide que ponga el dedo en las heridas, lo cual nos demuestra que Jesús sabía lo que Tomás había dicho. De vez en cuando todos dudamos, como lo hizo Tomás, por eso Tomás nos representa cada uno de nosotros y se le da la prueba a nuestro nombre. Por eso, al igual que él, estamos llamados a decir "Señor mío y Dios mío". Otra forma de ver este texto es que quizás Tomás se negó a creer debido a la persona a quién estaba escuchando. Quizás nosotros tampoco aceptamos algo como cierto debido a cómo vemos a quienes nos lo dicen. No importa quién difunda la fe, la fe la respalda Cristo y el Espíritu Santo para confirmarlo y por eso necesitamos escuchar y creer. ¡Dios los bendiga! P. Eric
