FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO

In the first reading from the Prophet Ezekiel, God gives Ezekiel the strength to speak to the rebellious people of Israel. Even though the people are stubborn, God still sends His prophet. This shows us that God never gives up on His People no matter how far they stray. Friends, Ezekiel's mission reminds us that sometimes we are called to speak the truth, even when it is difficult. We might face resistance or rejection, but God wants us to keep going. God will give us the strength we need to carry out His will and mission here on earth.

In the second reading, St. Paul talks about his weaknesses and hardships. He explains that these challenges allow Christ's power to shine through. This teaches us that our struggles can help us grow closer to God. Paul's message is clear: we do not need to be perfect to be loved by God. Our weaknesses and difficulties can be opportunities for God's strength to be shown. We can embrace our struggles and trust that God is working through them.

The Gospel reading shows Jesus visiting His hometown of Nazareth. Despite His wisdom and miracles, the people reject Him because they see Him as just a carpenter's son. This lack of faith amazes Jesus. Jesus' experience in Nazareth shows us how important faith is. Even though Jesus had the power to perform miracles, the people's unbelief limited what He could do. This teaches us that our faith plays a crucial role in receiving God's blessings.

We are reminded to have faith in Jesus, even when others doubt or reject Him. Our belief in Jesus' power can open the door to His healing, protection, and blessing. God bless!

En la primera lectura del profeta Ezequiel, Dios le da a Ezequiel la fuerza para hablarle al pueblo rebelde de Israel. Aunque el pueblo era terco, Dios todavía envía a su profeta. Esto nos muestra que Dios nunca se da por vencido con Su Pueblo, sin importar cuán lejos se desvíe. Amigos, la misión de Ezequiel nos recuerda que a veces somos llamados a decir la verdad, incluso cuando es difícil. Puede que enfrentemos resistencia o rechazo, pero Dios quiere que sigamos adelante. Dios nos dará la fuerza que necesitamos para llevar a cabo Su voluntad y misión aquí en la tierra.

En la segunda lectura, San Pablo habla de sus debilidades y dificultades. Explica que estos desafíos permiten que el poder de Cristo brille. Esto nos enseña que nuestras luchas pueden ayudarnos a acercarnos más a Dios. El mensaje de Pablo es claro: no necesitamos ser perfectos para ser amados por Dios. Nuestras debilidades y dificultades pueden ser oportunidades para que se muestre la fuerza de Dios. Podemos aceptar nuestras luchas y confiar en que Dios está obrando a través de ellas.

La lectura del Evangelio muestra a Jesús visitando su ciudad natal de Nazaret. A pesar de su sabiduría y milagros, la gente lo rechaza porque lo veían simplemente como el hijo de un carpintero. Esta falta de fe asombra a Jesús. La experiencia de Jesús en Nazaret nos muestra lo importante que es la fe. Aunque Jesús tenía el poder de realizar milagros, la incredulidad de la gente limitó lo que podía hacer. Esto nos enseña que nuestra fe juega un papel crucial a la hora de recibir las bendiciones de Dios.

Se nos recuerda que debemos tener fe en Jesús, incluso cuando otros dudan o lo rechazan. Nuestra creencia en el poder de Jesús puede abrir la puerta a Su sanación, protección y bendición. ¡Dios los bendiga!
