## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO

Today is the 34th and the last Sunday in Ordinary time and traditionally on this Sunday we solemnly celebrate the feast of “Christ the King,” a feast of God’s Kingdom, God’s Rule. With this, we also come to the end of the Liturgical Year B. Next Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent and with that, we go on to the new Liturgical Year C. This feast reminds us of our hope in Jesus’ eternal kingdom.

In the first reading from the prophet Daniel, we see a vision of “one like a Son of man” coming with the clouds of heaven. This figure receives all authority, glory, and a kingdom that will never end. This vision points to Jesus and His eternal kingship. Jesus’ kingdom is different from any earthly kingdom. Earthly kings come and go, but Jesus’ rule is everlasting. He has all the power and authority given by God. His kingdom is one of peace, justice, and love that will never fade away. Friends, Daniel’s vision shows all people, nations, and languages serving Jesus. This universal reign of Christ includes everyone. Jesus invites all of us into His kingdom, regardless of our background. His kingship is for everyone who believes and follows Him.

The Gospel shows Pilate judging Jesus by the world’s standards. We often judge others the same way. We look at their clothes, status, and actions. Pilate saw kingship as earthly power and control. When the Israelites asked for a king, God warned them of the heavy burdens a human king would bring. Worldly kings take from their people and rule through fear and power. They demand service and take what they want. Jesus’ kingship is different. He gives rather than takes. At the Last Supper, Jesus washed His disciples’ feet, showing that true kingship means serving others. Jesus does not seek to be served, but to serve. God Bless! Fr. Eric

*Hoy es el 34º y último domingo del tiempo ordinario y tradicionalmente en este domingo celebramos solemnemente la fiesta de “Cristo Rey”, una fiesta del Reino de Dios, el Gobierno de Dios. Con esto, también llegamos al final del Año Litúrgico B. El próximo domingo es el primer domingo de Adviento y con él, pasamos al nuevo Año Litúrgico C. Esta fiesta nos recuerda nuestra esperanza en el reino eterno de Jesús.*

*En la primera lectura del profeta Daniel, vemos una visión de “uno como un Hijo del hombre” que viene con las nubes del cielo. Esta figura recibe toda la autoridad, gloria y un reino que nunca terminará. Esta visión apunta a Jesús y su reinado eterno. El reino de Jesús es diferente de cualquier reino terrenal. Los reyes terrenales van y vienen, pero el gobierno de Jesús es eterno. Él tiene todo el poder y la autoridad dados por Dios. Su reino es uno de paz, justicia y amor que nunca se desvanecerá. Amigos, la visión de Daniel muestra a todas las personas, naciones y lenguas sirviendo a Jesús. Este reino universal de Cristo incluye a todos. Jesús nos invita a todos a su reino, independientemente de nuestro origen. Su reinado es para todos los que creen en Él y lo siguen.*

*El Evangelio muestra a Pilato juzgando a Jesús según los estándares del mundo. A menudo juzgamos a los demás de la misma manera. Observamos su ropa, su estatus y sus acciones. Pilato veía el reinado como poder y control terrenales. Cuando los israelitas pidieron un rey, Dios les advirtió de las pesadas cargas que traería un rey humano. Los reyes mundanos toman de su pueblo y gobiernan mediante el miedo y el poder. Exigen servicio y toman lo que quieren. El reinado de Jesús es diferente. Él da en lugar de tomar. En la Última Cena, Jesús lavó los pies de sus discípulos, mostrando que el verdadero reinado significa servir a los demás. Jesús no busca ser servido, sino servir. ¡Dios los bendiga! Padre Eric*
