FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO

St. Paul in our second reading for this weekend masses talks about the Holy Spirit giving different gifts to people. These gifts are meant to help the community and show God's love. Paul lists several gifts, such as wisdom, knowledge, faith, and healing. Each person receives a gift that can be used to help others. Friends, Paul's message reminds us that everyone has something valuable to contribute. No one person has all the gifts, so we need each other. When we use our gifts together, we can do great things for our community and the Church. We should encourage each other to use these gifts for the good of everyone.

In the Gospel we have the story of the wedding at Cana. Jesus performs His first miracle by turning water into wine. This miracle shows Jesus' power and care for others. Jesus' action at Cana also symbolizes how He can transform our lives. Just as He changed water into wine, He can change our hearts and make us new. This story encourages us to trust in Jesus' ability to help and guide us.

Friends, Mary's role in the wedding at Cana cannot be overemphasized. Mary notices that the wine has run out and asks Jesus to help. Her faith and care for others are evident in her actions. Mary's request to Jesus shows her trust in Jesus' ability to help. Mary serves as an example of faith and intercession. Just as she asked Jesus to help at the wedding, we can ask her to intercede for us with her Son. God Bless! Fr. Eric

En la segunda lectura de la Misa de este fin de semana, San Pablo habla de cómo el Espíritu Santo otorga diferentes dones a las personas. Estos dones tienen como fin ayudar a la comunidad y mostrar el amor de Dios. Pablo enumera varios dones, como la sabiduría, el conocimiento, la fe y la sanación. Cada persona recibe un don que puede utilizar para ayudar a los demás. Amigos, el mensaje de Pablo nos recuerda que todos tenemos algo valioso que aportar. Nadie tiene todos los dones, por lo que nos necesitamos unos a otros. Cuando usamos nuestros dones juntos, podemos hacer grandes cosas por nuestra comunidad y por la Iglesia. Debemos animarnos unos a otros a utilizar estos dones para el bien de todos.

En el Evangelio tenemos la historia de la boda en Caná. Jesús realiza su primer milagro al convertir el agua en vino. Este milagro muestra el poder de Jesús y su cuidado por los demás. La acción de Jesús en Caná también simboliza cómo puede transformar nuestras vidas. Así como convirtió el agua en vino, puede cambiar nuestros corazones y hacernos nuevos. Esta historia nos anima a confiar en la capacidad de Jesús para ayudarnos y guiarnos.

Amigos, el papel de María en la boda de Caná no puede ser sobreestimado. María se da cuenta de que el vino se ha acabado y le pide a Jesús que les ayude. Su fe y su preocupación por los demás son evidentes en sus acciones. La petición de María a Jesús muestra su confianza en la capacidad de Jesús para ayudar. María sirve como ejemplo de fe e intercesión. Así como le pidió a Jesús que la ayudara en la boda, podemos pedirle que interceda por nosotros ante su Hijo. ¡Dios los bendiga! Padre Eric
