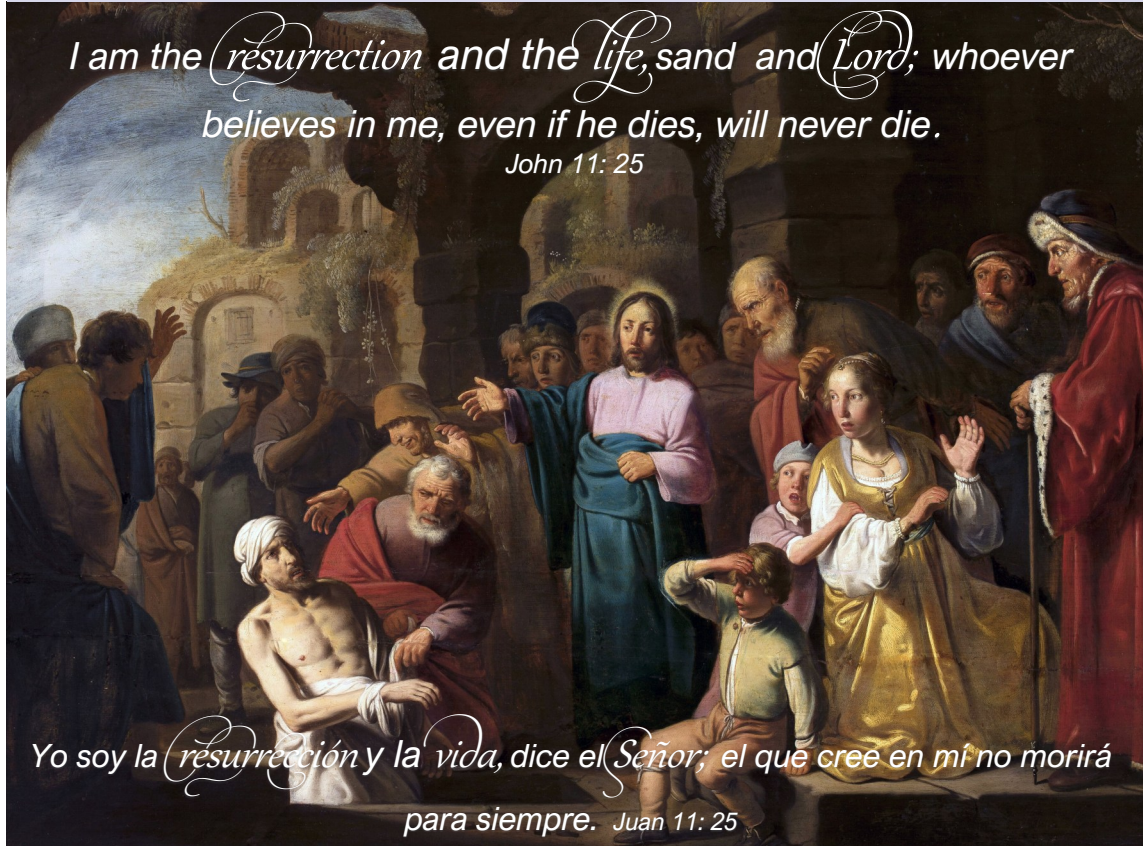

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO



Today is the 5th Sunday of Lent, and the last but one week of Lent. This will be followed by 'Passion Sunday,' (Palm Sunday) and finally 'the Holy Week' that will reach its peak on 'Easter Sunday.' The central theme of today's Scripture Readings is the resurrection and the life. In the Gospel Reading of today from St. John, we have the story of the raising of Lazarus from the dead, to bring him back to life, symbolizing that **"Jesus himself is the resurrection and the life."** This miracle leads us to believe in resurrection and new life which exists in Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

Friends, many people ask, **'After death, what?'** Why the question in the first place? Perhaps because death is the end of our plans and aspirations in life. Perhaps because of the thought of permanent separation from our loved ones. Perhaps because of the uncertainty about what lies beyond. Or perhaps because we just cannot accept the incontrovertible signs of our mortality, namely, sickness, pain and deterioration - physically, emotionally and psychologically. Jesus, who says, **"I am the resurrection and the life,"** gives meaning to our pains, trials and even death. When we accept all these in faith and love, then our many other deaths acquire a special meaning. For when we center our life in Jesus, when we begin to die to our selfishness and live for others, then Jesus will be glorified in us. This is what it means to rise in glory with him even now.

As followers of Jesus, we believe in the resurrection of the dead; that death is not the end of everything. Rather, it is just a passage into eternal life and that the life hereafter is only a continuation of this life. But this life after death could be ours only on one condition, namely, to believe in Jesus, **"He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die."** During the season of Lent, the Church invites us to die to ourselves - the only way for Jesus to become our Life and Resurrection. God Bless! Fr. Eric

Hoy es el quinto domingo de Cuaresma, y la penúltima semana de este tiempo litúrgico. A este le seguirá el «Domingo de la Pasión» (Domingo de Ramos) y, finalmente, la «Semana Santa», que alcanzará su culmen en el «Domingo de Pascua». El tema central de las lecturas bíblicas de hoy es la resurrección y la vida. En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy, según San Juan, encontramos el relato de la resurrección de Lázaro —su retorno a la vida—, lo cual simboliza que «Jesús mismo es la resurrección y la vida». Este milagro nos lleva a creer en la resurrección y en la vida nueva que existe en Jesús por medio del Espíritu Santo.

Amigos, muchas personas se preguntan: «¿Qué hay después de la muerte?». ¿Por qué surge esta pregunta en primer lugar? Quizás porque la muerte representa el fin de nuestros planes y aspiraciones en la vida. Quizás por la idea de una separación definitiva de nuestros seres queridos. Quizás por la incertidumbre acerca de lo que nos aguarda más allá. O tal vez porque, simplemente, no logramos aceptar los signos incontrovertibles de nuestra propia mortalidad: la enfermedad, el dolor y el deterioro —tanto físico como emocional y psicológico—. Jesús, quien afirma: «Yo soy la resurrección y la vida», otorga sentido a nuestros dolores, a nuestras pruebas e incluso a la muerte misma. Cuando aceptamos todo esto con fe y amor, nuestras múltiples «muertes» cotidianas adquieren un significado especial. Pues, al centrar nuestra vida en Jesús —al comenzar a «morir» a nuestro propio egoísmo para vivir por los demás—, es entonces cuando Jesús es glorificado en nosotros. Esto es lo que significa resucitar con Él en gloria, incluso desde ahora.

Como seguidores de Jesús, creemos en la resurrección de los muertos; creemos que la muerte no es el final de todo. Por el contrario, es tan solo un tránsito hacia la vida eterna, y que la vida del más allá no es sino una continuación de esta vida presente. Sin embargo, esta vida después de la muerte solo podrá ser nuestra bajo una única condición: creer en Jesús. Él mismo nos dice: «El que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá; y todo aquel que vive y cree en mí, no morirá jamás». Durante el tiempo de Cuaresma, la Iglesia nos invita a «morir a nosotros mismos»: el único camino para que Jesús se convierta verdaderamente en nuestra Vida y nuestra Resurrección. ¡Que Dios los bendiga! 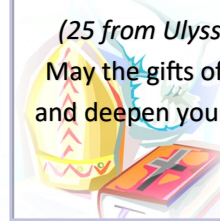
