FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR | DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARRACO



As we enter Holy Week and celebrate Palm Sunday, we remember the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. His sacrifice gives us hope for eternal life with God, even though death is a reality for all. The Liturgy of this Palm Sunday allows us to experience both joy and sadness, success and failure, and victory and defeat.

I would say that the Liturgy of the Word for Palm Sunday could be divided into two parts. The first part brings us joy and triumphs as we reflect on the glorious entry of Jesus to Jerusalem. The traditional blessing of palms, as well as the re-enactment of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem, bring us a sense of victory. As Jesus enters Jerusalem, the people gave him a welcome fitted to a King. With the waving of palms in their hands and the singing of 'hosanna', they praised God. "And as he was now drawing near, at the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciple began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, saying; **'Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest.'**" The second part, however, invites us to reflect on the passion and death of our Lord Jesus. This is the reason why, for me, Palm Sunday is both an experience of joy and pain. We are almost sure of what's going on in Jesus' mind as he enters Jerusalem. He knew that great suffering and death await him there. He had already predicted several times in the past about his impending persecution and death; yet like a lamb, he willingly welcomed and embraced his fate.

Friends, the image of Jesus hanging on the Cross is a reflection of what is there deep inside the heart of God – it is filled with his love for mankind. We are unworthy but Christ in his obedience to the will of the Father took our place and died for us. The Cross of Jesus is a sign of Love and a sign of Life. As we begin Holy Week, we, therefore, enter into the very core of the heart of God. Our deepest longing should not only be a sense of gratitude but a profound desire to change our ways so that somehow, we may be worthy of God's love. God Bless! Fr. Eric

Al adentrarnos en la Semana Santa y celebrar el Domingo de Ramos, recordamos la muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo. Su sacrificio nos brinda la esperanza de la vida eterna junto a Dios, aun cuando la muerte es una realidad para todos. La Liturgia de este Domingo de Ramos nos permite experimentar tanto la alegría como la tristeza, el éxito y el fracaso, la victoria y la derrota.

Diría que la Liturgia de la Palabra del Domingo de Ramos podría dividirse en dos partes. La primera parte nos trae alegría y triunfo al reflexionar sobre la entrada gloriosa de Jesús en Jerusalén. La tradicional bendición de las palmas, así como la representación de la entrada de Jesús en Jerusalén, nos infunden un sentido de victoria. Al entrar Jesús en Jerusalén, el pueblo le ofreció una bienvenida digna de un Rey. Agitando palmas en sus manos y entonando el «Hosanna», alababan a Dios: «Y cuando ya se acercaba a la bajada del Monte de los Olivos, toda la multitud de los discípulos comenzó a regocijarse y a alabar a Dios a gran voz por todas las obras poderosas que habían visto, diciendo: **"¡Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor! ¡Hosanna en el cielo!" ¡Paz en el cielo y gloria en las alturas!"**». La segunda parte, sin embargo, nos invita a reflexionar sobre la pasión y muerte de nuestro Señor Jesús. Esta es la razón por la cual, para mí, el Domingo de Ramos constituye una experiencia que aúna alegría y dolor. Podemos estar casi seguros de lo que pasaba por la mente de Jesús al entrar en Jerusalén. Él sabía que allí le aguardaban grandes sufrimientos y la muerte. Ya había predicho en varias ocasiones su inminente persecución y muerte; y, sin embargo, cual cordero, acogió y abrazó su destino con total disposición.

Amigos, la imagen de Jesús pendiendo de la Cruz es un reflejo de lo que reside en lo más profundo del corazón de Dios: un corazón colmado de amor por la humanidad. Nosotros somos indignos, pero Cristo, en su obediencia a la voluntad del Padre, ocupó nuestro lugar y murió por nosotros. La Cruz de Jesús es un signo de Amor y un signo de Vida. Por consiguiente, al dar inicio a la Semana Santa, nos adentramos en el núcleo mismo del corazón de Dios. Nuestro anhelo más profundo no debería limitarse a un sentimiento de gratitud, sino que debería ser un deseo vehemente de transformar nuestras vidas para que, de algún modo, podamos hacernos dignos del amor de Dios. ¡Que Dios los bendiga!
